

By receiving love and care through Foster Families, Prevention Homes, Family Restoration and Education Programs, at-risk children can live safely, go to school and follow their dreams.*

Thanks to the support of people like you, we have effectively prevented over 15,000 children from being sold in 20 countries, and taught preventive education to over 9,000 children.
